RSAP Overview

Lewis Clark Valley Metropolitan Planning Organization (LCVMPO) is preparing a Regional Safety Action Plan (RSAP). The RSAP will present a holistic, well-defined strategy to reduce roadway fatalities and serious injuries in the LCVMPO region.

The RSAP will analyze safety needs, identify high-risk locations and factors contributing to crashes, and prioritize strategies to address them.

The RSAP will meet eligibility requirements that allow local jurisdictions to apply for Implementation Grants from the United States Department of Transportation (USDOT) Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) program (https://www.transportation.gov/grants/SS4A)

Meeting Purpose

- The GFA meetings in March will present an initial roadway safety analysis customized to each GFA to inform local staff and officials about roadway safety for their community.
- 2. These GFA meetings are intended to be technical in nature to analyze trends and risk factors from current crash data and other roadway data resources.
- **3.** This discussion will inform potential roadway safety strategies which will be the subject of a second round of GFA meetings this summer 2024.
